Exterior painting of the Sherpa House is a resemble of a Traditional Buddhist monastery in Nepal and Tibet. White dots under the roof is a symbol of Moon and the black stripe underneath is the protection form bad weather, thunderstorm and lightning . The significance of the black frame around the doors and windows is to protect from outside evil or bad spirit entering in the house or monastery. Inside the Sherpa House, artifacts have been placed in traditional locations in the household, consisting of a family living room with kitchen, a shrine room and a gallery room.
